**Symbol Number**

 310 - Front & back buckets, grill & grey areas on front side of tractor, cables, lights, bolts, tires, inside cab window, smokestacks, levers inside cab

 801 - everything else

**SPLIT STITCHES** - When two split stitches fall within one grid square, always work the 3/4 stitch for what is in front (on top) in the design and the 1/4 stitch for what is in back (underneath) in the design.

Besides stitching this free pattern for a Love Quilt Square, try this idea:

Make a little boy or girl happy and stitch this pattern on Aida to adorn a sweatshirt, jersey, overalls, blanket, or pillow.

When stitching is complete, trim 1 inch around design, fold under edges 1/2" to wrong side & iron in place.

Trace outline of design onto fusible webbing and fuse to wrong side of Aida following directions that came with fusible webbing.

Peel off paper backing and place design in desired position on clothing and iron to item.

You may then hand stitch down edges to make extra **SECURE**.

I have finished many a pattern this way for my children and they go through the washer and dryer without any problem.
